- You will answer all of the questions on the chapter 12 Study Guide handout. You may work as a group to help answer the questions. **You must answer the essential questions.**
- Once we have gone over the answers, you will create a product (Choices above) to demonstrate your understanding of each Essential Question. Therefore, each student is responsible for a product. You will create one product for each section. (**NOTE: You are only doing one section at a time!!!!**)
- After each essential question has been answered, each student needs to be prepared to share his/her product with the class.

## ESSENTIAL QUESTIONS:

- How did the transcontinental railroad and other railroads affect the growth of the United States?
- How did the United States Government and its people treat Native Americans, and what were the long-term results of this treatment?
- What factors influenced human migration west and what were the effects of this migration?

## DIRECTIONS FOR PRODUCTS:

- Select any of the products listed under **YOUR LEARNING STYLE**, choosing a **DIFFERENT** product from your product list for each essential question (sections in chapter 12). Computer graphics and magazine cutouts may be used in place of free-hand drawing.
